Development work is now being carried out on an **iiMac • Intel Core 2 Duo**, and we are pleased to announce that all is progressing well and that the final product runs fine on the Intel based Macintoshes.

Just in case you haven't been told / reminded lately.

BACKUP!

We are using **SuperDuper** to regularly backup our system, files and all development work to an external hard disk. This is scheduled for automatic execution at 6 p.m. on Wednesday nights.

Parallels

We can't rave enough about this excellent product.

The external 23" Apple Cinema Display is / can be running, via

Elgato's eyeTV... a T.V. program, or full screen implementations
of Windows 98, 2000 Pro, XP, Ubuntu and Red Hat Linux. Currently version 2.2 but a new one in the pipeline allows you to open

Boot Camp and legacy VirtualPC disk images that you may have.

But, did you know: Any Windows OS will install fresh and clean, and as the exclusive OS, on any Intel-based Apple which has the latest Apple firmware updates. Don't forget to create the Macintosh Drivers Disk for XP before starting the XP installation.

Just stick a Windows XP (or Vista) install disk in the drive, and recycle the power. Windows installs normally. Don't forget to wipe all Apple partitions (including the EFI partition) off the disk before creating your Windows partitions. The best Intel-based machine with the best Intel-based OS will be yours in less than an hour.

NOTE: You will probably want a second HD, plus you must use a Full Retail or OEM XP or Vista Disk to accomplish this, since there is no way to eject the XP/Vista Upgrade disks when necessary on an Intel-based Apple.

Mac OSX - Leopard • Full 64 bit support • Boot Camp • Time Machine • Work Spaces • Spotlight • Core Animation • Mail • Notes & ToDo • Dashcode • WebClips... soon!

If you have not moved on to at least MAC OSX 10.4.8... it runs non-universal applications via Rosetta at speeds comparable to the native G5 chip.

Apple's computers now run on Intel Core 2 Duo chips as a minimum... Making the entry level MacBook 7 times faster than the previous model.

- 1• **Virtual Desktop** D.O.A. on the Intel Core 2 Duo.
- 2• Media Central Not required any more... although it is much richer than Apple's FrontRow
- 3• CarbonCopy Cloner Authentication problems with Tiger, iiMac... use SuperDuper.
- 4• **Microsoft Mouse** Requires new driver ... version 6.0 (.147)
- 5• The ability to run any **Windows** or **Unix** operating system concurrently with the Mac OSX environment is excellent, especially as documents and files may be shared and moved via common folders, etc. and you can simply drag and drop your Windows disk images for backup.
