# Our Product

We are currently hard at work on TheP (11i), for Intel based Macintosh computers.

This will be on our next release CD and will be an optional upgrade carrying a small upgrade charge.

Changes...

Compiled for running natively on Intel ( much faster ).

SQL 92 compliant ( much richer querying capabilities )

Limitations greatly extended (bigger tables, longer text, etc.)

Enhanced picture handling ( drag-drop, background use, animated GIF, etc )

Configurable indexing options (optimizing end-user performance)

Improved menus (contextual capabilities via splash screen)

4DView spread sheeting (colour cells, columns, rows, etc)

Simplified index repairs (fast, automatable)

Integrated 4DTools (better user access and implementation)

#### Mac OSX

Updated desktop Macs are faster - up to 2.8 GHz - and cheaper, and have a sleeker alumina and glass case design. A very classy look but also very good for recycling considerations.

iLife 8 - iPhoto 8 now has theme based cataloging and one click publishing of photos to .Mac Published photos may be collaborated. iMovie 8 centralizes your movie media for easy creation of composite movies in an expedient environment. DVD quality output to a .Mac site. iWeb now implements widgets and links to other web services such as Google maps. Garageband comes with a new interface for initiating a musical session.

.Mac members now receive 10Gb of storage and full integration with the new iLife capabilities These new features are also available on the .Mac site.

iWork 8 - Keynote has new transitions. Pages works in Word Process or Page Layout modes. The new "Numbers" imports / exports MsExcel and creates great presentation style spreadsheets.

32% of all music sold in 2006 was via digital download only.




